

## Program Capacity

**CATS** manages numerous programs targeting a variety of specific populations. **CATS** offers multiple levels of care ranging from outpatient to residential treatment. At present **CATS** has the capacity to serve 135 clients in their residential facilities:

**27** men in the **Residential Therapeutic Community**, which provides three to six months of treatment.

**8** men in the **Residential Modified Therapeutic Community**, which provides three to six months of treatment.

**46** men in the **Men's Residential Treatment Program**, which provides one to three months of treatment.

**54** women in the **Women's Residential Treatment Program**, which provides one to three months of treatment.

**CATS Plus** currently has the capacity to serve **20** men for twelve months of residential support and workforce readiness training.

Our **Outpatient Programs** serve up to **90** individuals a day, providing assessments, individual and group counseling, and case management.

## History & Mission

Since its inception in 1990, Community Assessment & Treatment Services, Inc. (CATS) has provided premier treatment serving primarily, men and women returning from, or involved in, the criminal justice system.

**CATS' Mission** is to provide high quality, cost effective, holistic, abstinence-based intervention and prevention services. These services address the chemical dependency and/or mental health needs of a diverse clientele.

In addition to treatment, CATS offers ancillary services such as trauma recovery, workforce readiness, financial literacy, recreation, community outreach, and holistic healing through music and art.

To date, CATS has **served over 34,000 individuals** and their families. CATS **experiences a 78% success rate**, defined as those who enter and complete their assigned level of care.

### ASSESSMENTS

- Comprehensive biopsychosocial interview.
- Used to determine the existence and/or severity of substance abuse issues.
- Helps to determine the level of care needed.
- Available to self-pay, Medicaid, court referrals, or agency referred individuals.

### RESIDENTIAL TREATMENT

- Cognitive - behavioral therapy model, supplemented with the 12-step model.
- Physical and mental health screenings and treatment referrals as needed.
- Available to self-pay or court referred individuals.

### CATS PLUS

- Housing, employment, and aftercare for successful program graduates or community referrals.



## Services

### NON-INTENSIVE OUTPATIENT

- Includes group counseling, individual counseling, assessments, urinalysis, and case management.
- Available also as a follow-up program for residential and intensive outpatient graduates.
- Available to self-pay, Medicaid and court-referred individuals.

### INTENSIVE OUTPATIENT

- A structured combination of services with a minimum participation requirement of three sessions and eight hours of treatment per week.
- Available to self-pay, Medicaid and court-referred individuals.

### CASE MANAGEMENT

- Services that addresses basic needs through self-sufficiency.
- Available to all program participants.
